

Tile Fundraiser Artwork Guidelines





Be sure your artist follows our artwork guidelines:

- Artwork should be created on clean, white paper in an 8 inch by 8 inch square. Paper is available at the Discovery Center for tiles, or you can use some you have at home.
- 2. Artwork must be a self-portrait of a child. Adults may create a self-portrait of themselves as a child.
- 3. Do not use photography, magazine cutouts, or copyrighted images.
- 4. Use bright, bold colors to create vibrant artwork that fills the entire square.
- 5. Work with markers, water colors, crayons, bold colored pencils, tempera paint, acrylic paint, or paint sticks.
- 6. Avoid using light colored pencils, florescent colors, highlighters, or 3D elements like glitter, feathers, and googly eyes.
- 7. Fill the full square, but keep important elements at least 1 inch away from the edge of the paper.
- 8. Submit art by August 8, 2025.
